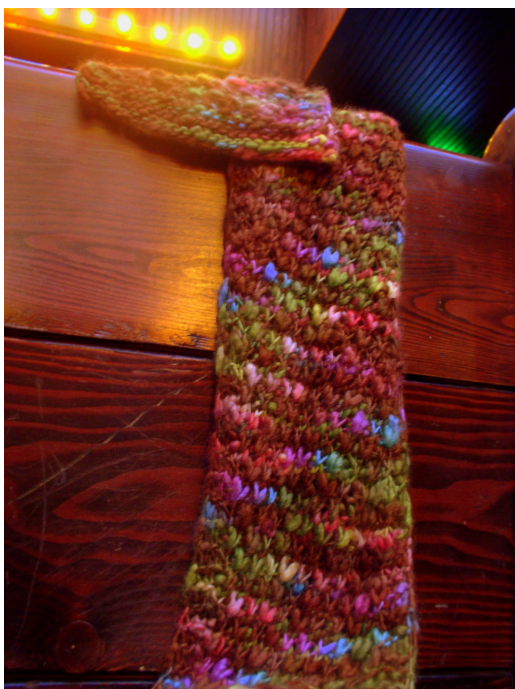


## Sqooshy Scarf

### Sizes:

Short (Long)

8" x 54" (6" x 72")

Shown: Short version

### Gauge:

3.25 sts = 1" in Garter Stitch

### Materials:

- 2 skeins of Fleece Artist Slubby Blue (100m/ 110y per 125g/ 4.40 oz skein) in two different colors – shown in "Morgana" & "Forest Fairie"
- Pair of 9mm/ US 13 needles

### Notions:

- Tapestry needle
- 2 Stitch markers

### Designers' Note:

The scarf shown was made with two different colors of Slubby Blue, MC & CC, that were alternated every two rows.

### ABBREVIATIONS

BO	Bind off
CO	Cast on
CC	Contrast color
K	Knit
K2tog	Knit two together
MC	Main color
Ndl	Needle
P	Purl
PM	Place marker
Sl1	Slip one
SM	Slip marker
St(s)	Stitch(es)
Tbl	Through back loop
wyif	With yarn in front



## PATTERN

### Border:

With CC, CO 26 (20) sts.

Rows 1 & 2: K across with CC.

Rows 3 & 4: K across with MC.

Rows 5 & 6: K across with CC.

### Main:

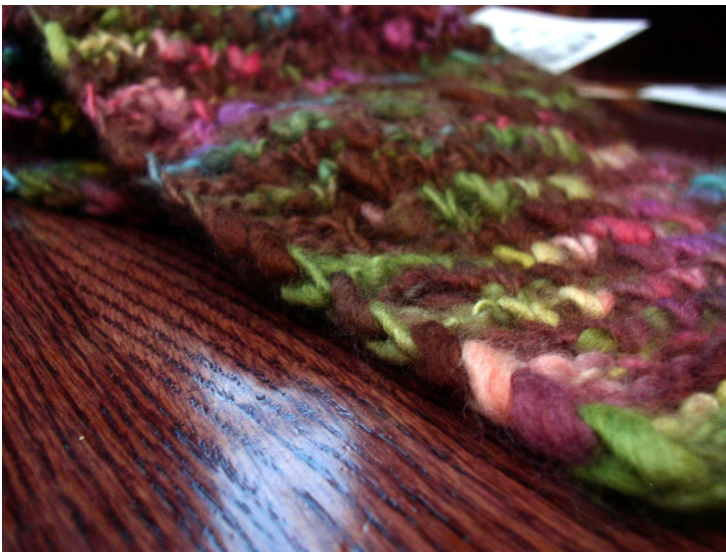
Row 1: With MC, Sl1 wyif, k2, PM, \*K2tog leaving sts on left ndl, k2tog again tbl \* 10 (7) times, PM, K3.

Row 2: With MC, Sl1 wyif, K2, SM, p20 (14), SM, k3.

Row 3: Join CC, Sl1 wyif, k2, SM, k1, \*K2tog leaving sts on left ndl, k2tog again tbl \* 9 (6) times, k1, SM, K3.

Row 4: With CC, Sl1 wyif, K2, SM, p20 (14), SM, k3.

Repeat Rows 1 – 4 until piece measures 53 (71)'' from CO edge. Be sure to end with Row 4.



### Border:

Rows 1 & 2: K across with MC.

Rows 3 & 4: K across with CC.

Row 5: K across with MC.

Row 6: BO with MC.

### Finishing:

Weave in ends and block lightly if necessary.
